- We will propose:

"I purpose Galway County Council send a letter from the CEO on behalf of management and staff and elected representatives of Galway Co Co to the proprietors management of the nursing homes and long stay residential care hospitals like St. Brendan's hospital Loughrea. Congratulating them on the extreme efforts of management and staff on minimizing the spread of Covid - 19 within residential care centers for the elderly.
