### **Online Home Fire Safety Checklist**

Galway Fire and Rescue Service have launched a self-assessment Online Home Fire Safety Checklist. This simple checklist will help you to rate the fire safety risk in your home and identify key areas for improvement. Once any improvements are made the on-line checklist should be completed again. The on-line checklist will help us to identify homes with a higher risk so that we can monitor that risk and if necessary, offer a Fire Service Home Fire Safety Visit and fit smoke detectors where appropriate.


