LCDC Elections

Galway County PPN sought nominations for 5 representative posts on the LCDC (Local Community Development Committee).

For the Environmental Pillar, we just had one nomination from the Headford Environmental Group and their nominee Venetia McEllin is deemed elected to the LCDC.

For the Social Inclusion Pillar, we had just 2 nominations for the 2 positions, both of them are deemed elected to the LCDC. Kevin Gavin nominated by Lámh Linn and Peter Gohery nominated by Co. Galway Disability Forum.

As more valid nominations were received for the Community & Voluntary representative posts than the seats available, in accordance with PPN Rules, an election took place with Máirín Ní Chonghaile and Gerard Costello being elected. These nominees are deemed elcted pending ratification from Galway County Council in September.


Carmichael Good Governance Awards 2021


