
ACTION – Mary Mullen to add Insurance webinar slides to website. Duana Tuite will include link to website in September Newsletter.

KEY POINTS FROM SUMMER PLENARY

Vincent Lyons told the group how Galway County PPN has the highest number of Social Inclusion groups registered in the Country. We are the 2nd largest PPN by number of member groups.

Vincent Lyons spoke on the low attendance from the secretariat at the Summer Plenary. We need the full Secretariat membership to attend Secretariat meetings and especially the Plenary events twice yearly. The poor turn out isn't good enough and is unfair on those who are putting in the time. If unavailable then apologies must be sent in advance of meeting.
