PPN Communications Guide – News for the Community & from the Community...

PPN Workers are here to help local community and voluntary groups and organisations to share their news with, and receive news from: the PPN network, local organisations, national Government and Galway County Council.

- **The PPN provides a link** between community and voluntary groups and the Local Authority and community sector organisations.
- **The flow of information goes both ways** with PPN workers in the middle gathering and sharing information from many sources.
- **Information shared with PPN members includes** funding and grants, training, resources, public consultations, surveys, information on local development plans, events, news, activities, meetings, support services. Communications sent out from PPN workers are aimed at community groups or specific local communities in County Galway, usually the activities or events promoted will be free, subsidised, or low cost.

PPN AIMS:

- **PPN Aim 1) Representation:** PPN community representative roles, public participation in local decision making, public consultations/meetings related to local plans/policy/strategies.
- **PPN Aim 2) Capacity Building:** training, funding/grants, networking, information events and resources for community groups/non-profit organisations in County Galway.
- **PPN Aim 3) Information Sharing:** other events, activities, meetings, services, supports, training, relevant to local communities, community groups and non-profit sectors in Galway County.

There are three PPN Pillars for members: **COMMUNITY & VOLUNTARY**, **SOCIAL INCLUSION** or **ENVIRONMENTAL**.

HOW NEWS IS SHARED:

- **Submit events directly to our website:** <https://www.galwaycountypnn.ie/event-directory/> - if you are promoting an event in County Galway relevant to the Community Sector.
- **Tag the PPN @GalwayCountyPPN** in your social media posts and we will try to share it if we have time (if it's priority, email us a link to your social media post).
- **PPN Newsletter:** The **PPN Monthly E-Newsletter** is issued the week of the **1st of a month**, and distributed via email to members, on our website, social media, at PPN meetings/events & with colleagues/networks.

Anything relevant to the 3 pillars of the PPN (Community & Voluntary, Social Inclusion, Environment).
- **Submissions deadline** is one week before newsletters are issued.
- **Weekly Digest:** Emailed to PPN members, usually on a Friday, issued most weeks if there is enough news. Digest Submissions via email to ppn@galwaycoco.ie by Thursday's 4pm.
- **What to Include for newsletter/social media/PPN website posts:** 50 words, a web link to read more, contact info, any image/poster in jpeg/png format (for emails we can send a PDF attachment).
- **Emails to PPN Members**, for highest priority news (i.e. Major news/events relevant to PPN, Funding Schemes, Consultations) - an email can be sent to all members of Galway County PPN (over 1300 organisations), or a cohort of members (filtered by Location: 5 Municipal Districts, PPN Pillar, or specific mailing lists - see members directory: <https://www.galwaycountypnn.ie/members-directory/>).
- **Please clearly outline** which part of your email is for us to forward to our members (e.g. do we include your email signature), and which cohort of our membership the news is for, remember to provide contact details.
