



## CEANTAR BARDASACH THUAMA TREOIRLÍNTE 2025 MAIDIR LEIS AN gCISTE CAIPITIL TACAÍOCHTA POBAIL 2025

Dáta Deiridh: Dé hAoine, An 18 Iúil 2025 @ 4pm

Aithníonn Comhairle Ceantair Bardasach Thuama agus Chomhairle Contae na Gaillimhe gurb iad pobail áitiúla ceann dár n-acmhainní is mó, agus mar aitheantas air sin, tá Ciste Caipitil Tacaíochta Pobail forbartha acu chun tacaíocht airgeadais a sholáthar trí mhaoiniú meaitseála do thionscadail chaipitil pobail.

### Riachtanais:

- Ní mór Foirmeacha Iarratais a chomhlánú go hiomlán trí <https://submit.link/3Vx> - ní bhreithneofar foirmeacha neamhiomlána ná iarratais gan na doiciméid éigeantacha riachtanacha.
- Cinntigh, le do thoil, gurb é Ainm an Ghrúpa a chuireann tú isteach ar d'iarratas ar líne Ainm Dlíthiúil do Ghrúpa, i.e., is ionann é sin agus an t-ainm atá ar do Chuntas Bainc agus ar an bhFoirm Bunaithe Soláthraithe.
- Moltar go mbunaithear cuntas ríomhphoist in ainm an ghrúpa don phróiseas iarratais deontais ar líne (seachas seoltaí ríomhphoist phearsanta is féidir a athrú le himeacht ama).
- Ní mór do Gach Grúpa a bheith bunaithe go hionchuí agus, má iarrtar é, fianaise den bhunú a sholáthar, clárú mar ghrúpa deonach chun críocha cánach nó aon doiciméid/aon ghrianghraif eile sa bhreis a cheanglaítear chun a stádas a dheimhniú go hiomlán.
- Ní mór d'iarratasóirí na spriocdhátaí maoinithe go léir do chéimeanna iarratais & tarraingthe anuas a chomhlíonadh agus, má éiríonn leo, ní féidir leo a dtionscadal faofa a athrú gan toiliú roimh ré.

### Doiciméid Éigeantacha:

- Cóip de do Ráiteas Cuntais Bainc/Comhair Creidmheasa is cothroime le dáta in ainm oifigiúil/dlíthiúil do Ghrúpa.
- Cruthúnas ar Bheartas Árachais Dlíteanais Phoiblí le slánú chuig Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe (ba cheart do chlóis súgartha phobail atá árachaithe faoi Chomhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe leathanach A4 a chur isteach ar a bhfuil a gcumhdach deimhnithe ag árachas a n-údarais áitiúil).
- Ní mór do gach iarratasóir 1 luachan ar a laghad a chur isteach do gach mír chaiteachais dá lorgaítear maoiniú deontais - cuirimid i gcuimhne duit a bheith ag 'Siopadóireacht go hÁitiúil' nuair is féidir, le do thoil.
- Ní mór go mbeadh aon chomhthoilithe reachtúla a cheanglaítear don togra tionscadail i bhfeidhm ag céim iarratais agus go gcuirfí cruthúnais isteach le d'iarratas.

### Roghnú Tionscadail:

Leagtar amach na critéir seo a leanas chun cabhrú le tionscadail atá le maoiniú a aithint agus comhaontú a dhéanamh orthu:

- Riachtanas agus Leas Pobail: a mhéid a chomhlíonann togra an tionscadail easnamh sainaitheanta i mbonneagar pobail agus sóisialta.
- Ailíniú Beartais: a mhéid a bhfuil an togra tionscadail ailínithe le haidhmeanna agus cuspóirí Phlean Forbartha an Chontae, sprioc straitéiseach de chuid an Phlean Eacnamaíoch agus Pobail Áitiúil, agus comhlántacht le beartais, clár agus cuspóirí eile de chuid na Comhairle nó an Rialtais.
- Luach ar Airgead: a mhéid a léiríonn aon tionscadal atá beartaithe luach maith ar airgead, lena n-áirítear gnéithe amhail:
  - Éifeachtúlacht costais: tograí a bhfuil costas soiléir orthu agus atá i gcomhréir le soláthar poiblí.
  - Acmhainn: tá acmhainn ann an tionscadal a sheachadadh in am agus laistigh den bhuiséad.
  - Caighdeán: leibhéal an mhaoinithe meaitseála atá ag teastáil i gcomparáid le haschur tionscadail chéimnithe/chríochnaithe.
  - Inseachadtacht: in ann é a sheachadadh laistigh de scálaí ama na scéime / maoinithe.
  - Inmharthanacht: socrúithe cothabhála amach anseo i bhfeidhm.

## THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF TUAM COMMUNITY SUPPORT CAPITAL FUND 2025 GUIDELINES

Closing Date: Friday, 18th July 2025 @ 4pm

The Municipal District of Tuam and Galway County Council recognises that local communities are one of our greatest resources, and in recognition of this, has developed the Community Support Capital Fund to provide financial support by means of match-funding for community capital projects.

### Requirements:

- Application Forms must be fully completed via <https://submit.link/3Vx> - incomplete forms or applications without required compulsory documentation will not be considered.
- Please ensure that the Group Name you enter on your online application is the legal name of your Group, i.e., same as that on your Bank Account and Supplier Set-Up Form.
- It is recommended that an e-mail account in the group's name be set up for the online grant application process (instead of personal e-mail addresses which can change over time).
- All Groups must be properly constituted and if requested, must provide evidence of a constitution, registration as a voluntary group for tax purposes, or any other additional documents/photos required to fully establish their status.
- Applicants must comply with all funding deadlines for application & drawdown stages, and if successful, cannot change their approved project without prior consent.

### Compulsory Documentation:

- Copy of your most up-to-date Bank/Credit Union Account Statement in the official/legal name of your Group.
- Proof of Public Liability Insurance Policy with indemnification to Galway County Council (community playgrounds insured under Galway County Council should submit an A4 page confirming their coverage by their local authority insurance).
- All applicants must submit a minimum of 1 quotation for each expenditure item for which grant funding is sought - we remind you to please 'Shop Local' where possible.
- Any statutory consents required for the project proposal must be in place at application stage and proofs submitted with your application.

### Project Selection:

The following criteria are set out to assist in the identification of, and agreement on, projects for funding:

- Need and Community Gain: the extent to which the project proposal meets an identified deficit in community & social infrastructure.
- Policy Alignment: the extent to which the project proposal aligns with the aims and objectives of the County Development Plan, a strategic goal of the Local Economic and Community Plan, and complementarity to other Council or Government policies, programmes and objectives.
- Value for Money: the extent to which any proposed project represents good value for money, including aspects such as:
  - Cost-effectiveness: clearly costed proposals compliant with public procurement.
  - Capacity: project has capacity to be delivered on time and in budget.
  - Quality: level of match funding required v outputs of phased / completed project.
  - Deliverability: capable of being delivered within scheme / funding timescales.
  - Sustainability: arrangements for future maintenance in place.
